

SITE RULES & CONDITIONS

The person in whose name the booking was made is held responsible for the behaviour of all other persons in the party and for ensuring that these conditions are adhered to by all members of the party. **Booking from persons under 19 cannot be accepted.**

- 1 A deposit will be taken, on arrival, for the Card Key used to access the services. This deposit will be refunded when the Card Key is returned to reception.
- 2 Damages must be reported immediately and paid for before leaving the High Range.
- 3 The sites are available from 4pm on the day of arrival until 10am on the day of departure. Guests who anticipate **arriving after 6pm must** inform reception of expected time of arrival. We reserve the right to re-let the site if no notification is received. Guests wishing to extend their stay should inform reception, giving as much notice as possible. No guarantee can be given that you will be able to remain on the same site.
- 4 For reasons of safety no vehicle must exceed 10mph.
- 5 Litter - please put in the bins provided and remind children to do the same.
- 6 Fire regulations stipulate that only **1 car per pitch is permitted**. Parking must be adhered to.
- 7 Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times. Owners must exercise dogs off the site and are **responsible for cleaning up after them**.
- 8 Guests must take all reasonable precautions to prevent an outbreak of fire. Every caravan should be equipped with a fully operational fire extinguisher.
- 9 Guests must accept responsibility for their own property.
- 10 In consideration of other guests, noise levels must be kept to a minimum at all times.
- 11 **No smoking** is permitted in any areas of the service block.
- 12 Children under the age of 13 **must not enter** the service block unless accompanied by an adult. We reserve the right to **remove any persons** from the High Range who are **in breach of the above Conditions of Hire**.

THE COMPLEX

The High Range has been under the personal supervision of the Vastano family for the past twenty eight years, where the standards and style have been influenced by continuity and continental flair.

The Complex is situated in its own birch woodland park at the south end of Aviemore on the B9152 road directly opposite the Coylumbridge B970 road leading to Loch Morlich and the ski slopes, commanding a splendid view of Craigellachie Nature Reserve, the Lairig Ghru Pass, and most prominent of all, the peaks and ski-runs of the Cairngorms.

Our guests enjoy the seclusion and privacy of the complex woodland, but are only a five minute walk from the Aviemore shopping and village centre.
